****GOOD NEWS**** In view of the slight relaxation of the rules by the Government, we are able to open for **Sunday Club this Sunday 5th July between 12 and 2pm**, if the weather is dry. The weather looks good but **if it is raining it will be cancelled**. We are looking forward to re-opening, even in this very minor way and are working hard to make this an enjoyable, comfortable and safe experience for

everyone. We are planning to have tables and chairs outside only, you will be able to order your drinks at a table outside and we ask that everyone pays by card please. Tables will be sanitised regularly and it is to be hoped that everyone practices safe socialising. I'm sure many people are desperate for some social interaction after the last few months, so please do drop by, even if only for a few minutes to say hello. **We would love to see you**. If you can't manage this weekend please put **2nd August** in your diaries.

Unfortunately, there is as yet no sign of being able to open as a theatre anytime soon. Even with social distancing reduced to 1 metre we could only seat about 100 people but that is way better than the 40 we can seat at 2 metres.

Looking to the future, we are hoping to have some live-streaming events by local bands including Groove Hoover as soon as we are allowed to do so.
