We have lost so many dear friends this month as you will see in this edition of BTN. One of these was Dave. He was well known to many at the Theatre for some 30 years, having performed for The Oxted Players from the 1970s, and was a prominent and active member of their Committee, responsible for publicity until the 1990s. He was also on the Friends of the Barn Committee for many years taking charge of the stock. He loved performing and appeared in many productions for the Oxted Players including *The Happiest Days of Your Life* and *Hobson's Choice* which were two of his favourites. He also appeared in a few OOS productions including *South Pacific* and regularly sang in the Christmas Choir at The Barn. He last appeared on stage for TOPS in *Twelfth Night* in 2005 but family tragedies curtailed his activities. However, he still remained active with set building and painting until he suffered a stroke in 2011 which left him confined to a wheelchair. He was a true Welshman and a real gentleman and he will be sorely missed.
