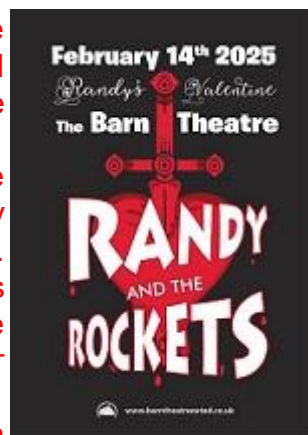
The band prides itself on quality performances from the Fleetwood Mac songbook, focused on the music and staged with costumes that recall the original band.


