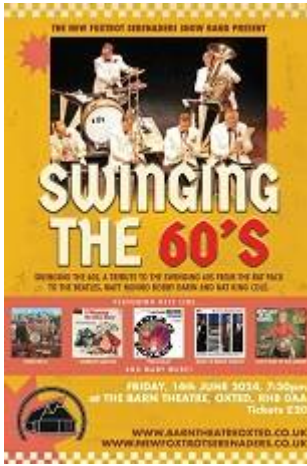

Come, sing along to the popular songs, marvel at the speciality acts and laugh with the comedian. An evening of entertainment that mustn't be missed.

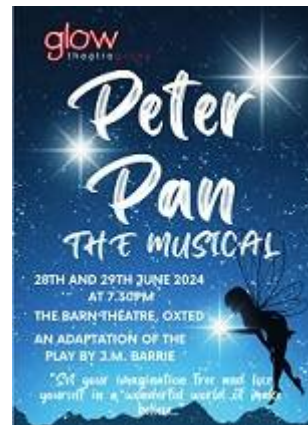


